National Student Advertising Competition (NSAC) Student Conduct Form

Each school must send a copy of the Student Conduct Form signed by all team members along with their Plans Books to both the District Coordinator and AAF headquarters no later than March 22, 2013 by 5:00pm EST.

Students are considered representatives of their college/university, the AAF and the advertising industry starting when they register at the NSAC competition venue, until their departure from the competition venue. Inappropriate behavior resulting in monetary damage will be the responsibility of the student and further disciplinary action may be sanctioned on a case-by-case basis, as deemed appropriate by the AAF and the respective college/university.

Each student must act responsibly at all times and comply with the following:

- You are representing your school and your talents. You should remember that your behavior will be observed by your peers and key industry leaders from around your district.
- The conference is not a vacation or holiday. It is a professional business meeting. You have excelled in the competition and have been invited to compete in a professional forum.
- Venue staff has been alerted to make an extra effort to ask for proper identification of anyone who they feel might be under the legal drinking age. The AAF will help to enforce this effort.
